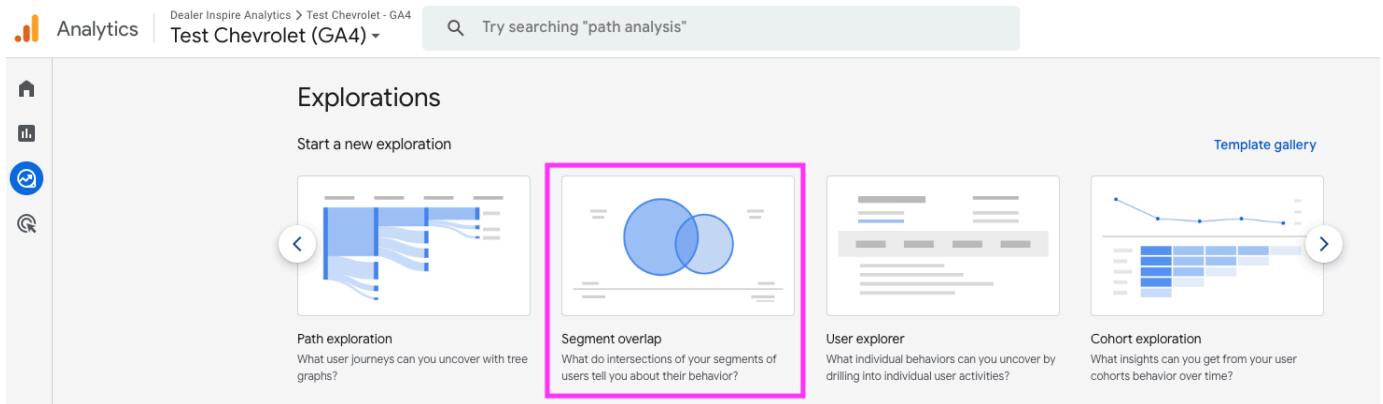


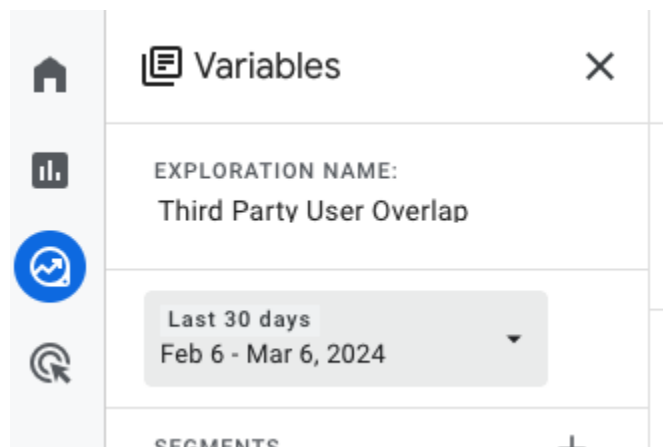
This report will show you how many overlapping users are coming from each of your sources of traffic. This report is great for showing a dealer that even though they may be on all 3 major third party sites, minimal amounts of their traffic are overlapping. This speaks to our [statistic that 70-90% of Cars.com visitors do not visit other third party sites](#).

To begin, navigate to the “Explore” section in your GA4 interface

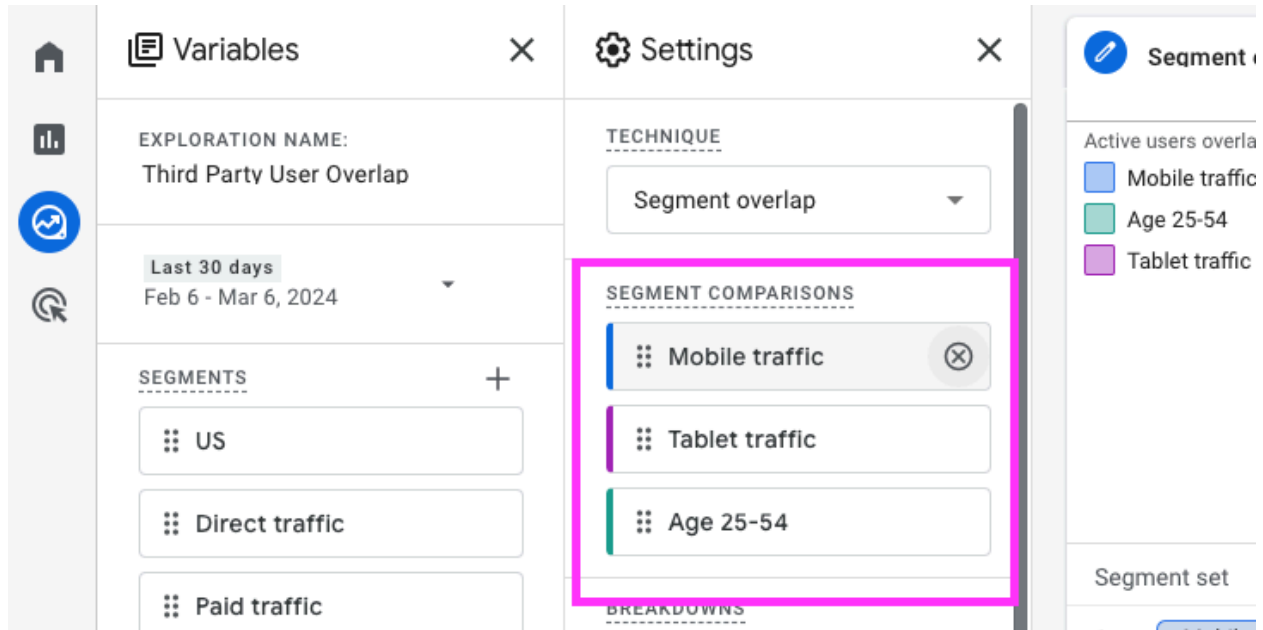
**Step 1** - From the exploration templates options, choose “Segment Overlap”



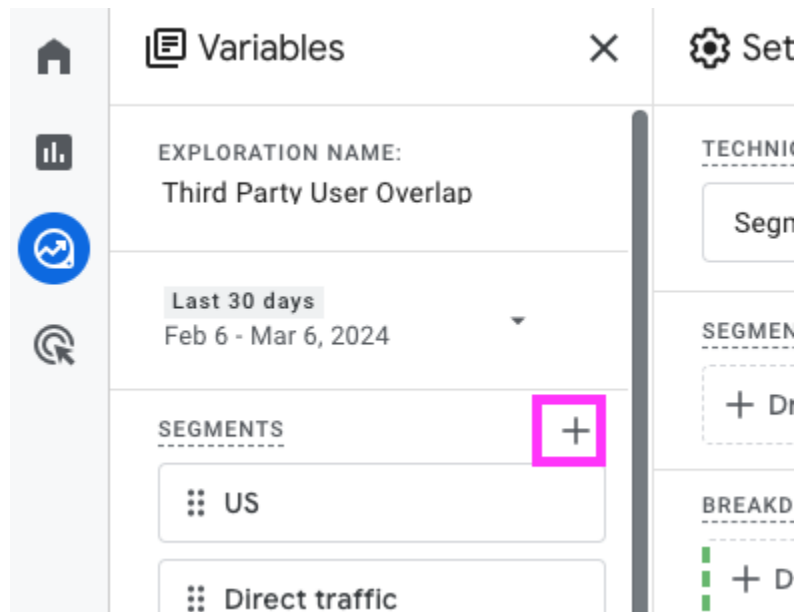
**Step 2** - Once you are in the report template, update the name of your exploration and change the date range to your desired timeframe.



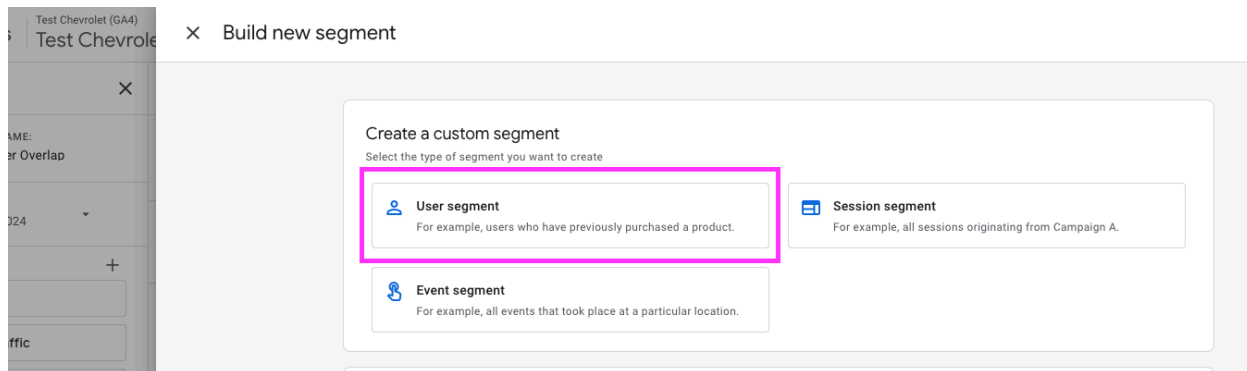
**Step 3** - From the “Settings” column, remove all the current “Segment Comparisons” using the X button on the right hand side of each.



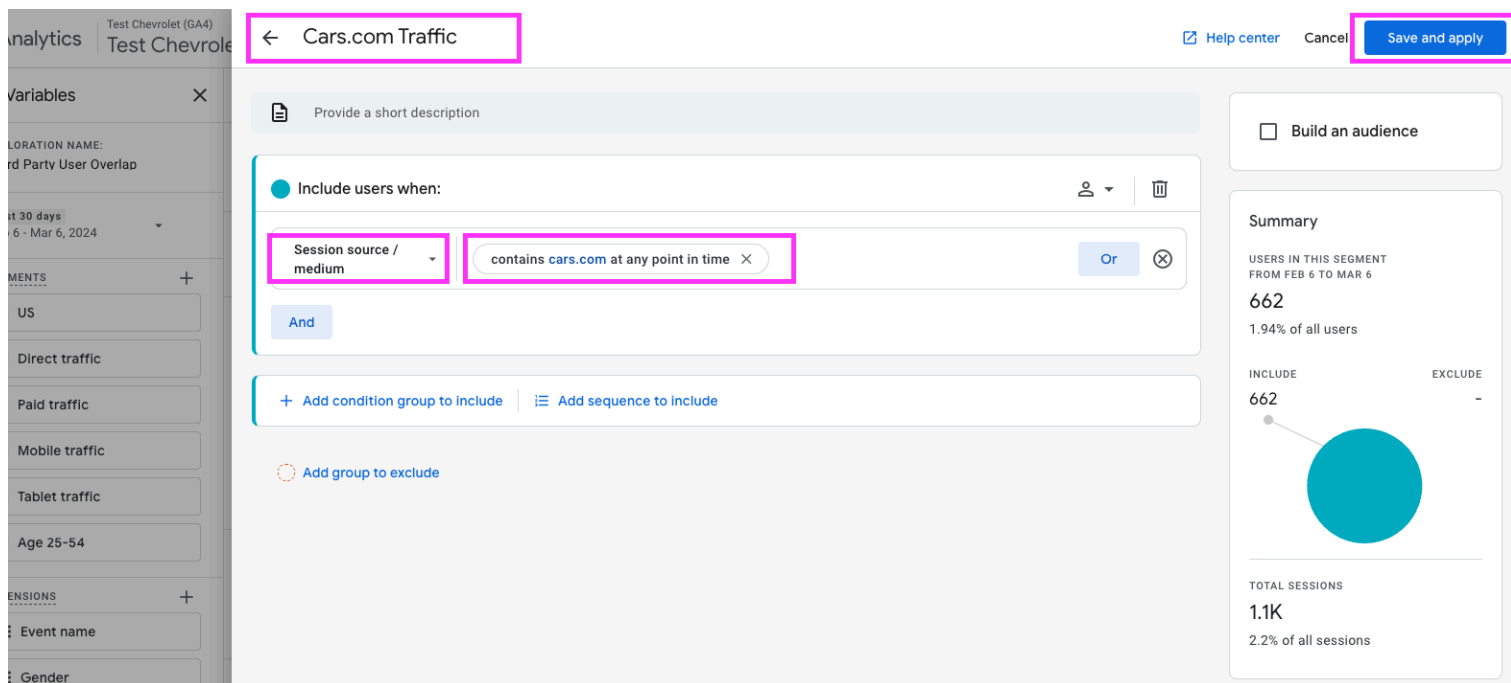
**Step 4** - Build your new Segments by clicking the + sign next to “Segments” under the “Variables” column. For this example, I will use Cars.com, Autotrader & Cargurus.



**Step 5** - To build a new segment, select “User Segment” from the options.



- Step 6** -
- Rename your Segment, in this example I’m using “Cars.com Traffic”.
  - Then, select the box that says “Add new condition” and start typing “Session source / medium”.
  - Once that populates, select it from the drop down.
  - Then, click “Add Filter” and use the “contains” condition.
  - In the blank field below “contains”, type in “cars.com” and hit “Apply”.
  - Once completed, Choose “Save & Apply” in the top right corner.



**Step 7** - repeat Step 6 for the other segments you want to create. For my example I'm using Autotrader & Cargurus. The "Values" metric under the "Settings" column should automatically be set to Active Users.

**Step 8** - you're finished! Now, looking at this report we can see that in the last 30 days, only 5 users overlapped between Cars & Autotrader and 2 users overlapped between Cars & Cargurus. No users were overlapping between all 3.
